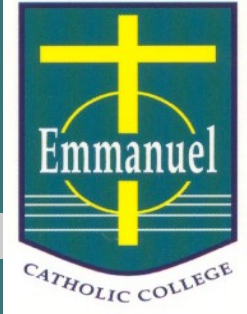


Newsletter

Study Tip #16 – Lists!

Developing a list is an effective memorization technique. When memorizing dates, formulae, etc., some find useful the most bare method of all--the list. When memorizing the scientific names of different organisms for a science class, for instance, a student could create two columns side by side--one listing the common names, the other listing the scientific names. By reading the list over several times and then covering up pieces of information so that you are forced to remember them, you can teach your brain to associate the two names more quickly.

YEAR 12 SEMESTER TWO EXAMINATIONS

Monday 5 October - Friday 16 October

Copies of the Examination Timetable have now been distributed to students in Year 12. On the reverse side of the Examination Timetable are printed the general instructions for examinations. These instructions must be strictly adhered to. If a student is absent for an examination, then it is expected that a **medical certificate** will be supplied in order to substantiate the reason for the absence.

Spare copies of the Examination Timetable are available at Student Reception.

It is the student's responsibility to ensure that he/she knows when and where his/her examinations will be held. Normal school rules apply during the examination period.

Year 12 students sitting for 4 or more examinations:

These students are only required to attend school to sit for their examinations; at other times, they are permitted to study at home.

Year 12 students sitting for less than 4 examinations:

Once Term Four commences, these students are permitted to study at home on the day prior to the day of the examination. At other times, they are to **attend classes, as normal** (unless directed otherwise), including on the day of the examination once the examination has been sat for.

Should Years 11 & 12 students involved in examinations wish to meet with particular teachers during the examination break, it is strongly recommended that a prior appointment be made to see the teacher concerned. **Students who come onto College grounds during the examination break for any reason whatsoever must be dressed in normal school uniform.**

Formal classes conclude for **students sitting for less than 4 examinations**, providing all assessment tasks have been submitted.

Friday 27 November:

Semester Two Examinations conclude.
