**Stage 1 and 2 units of Courses generally provide the foundation for Non-Tertiary pathways, which typically suit students who will seek employment or entry to TAFE at the end of Year 12.**

**Stage 2 and 3 units of Courses generally provide the foundation for Tertiary Bound pathways, and are undertaken by students who are planning to go to University at the end of Year 12. It is expected that students seeking University Entrance via a Tertiary Entrance Rank (TER) would be undertaking a programme of study comprising mostly Stage 3 Courses in Year 12.**
