Music Scholarship Information

Emmanuel Catholic College welcomes applications for Music Scholarships from both primary and secondary school students. The College offers a Music Program attracting students who have their sights set on attaining high levels of music excellence. Our tutors make available music accreditation as an option through a variety of world-wide institutions. The Emmanuel Music Program is fully supportive of students gaining external accreditation in performance, musicianship and music theory. Performance opportunities are offered both internally and externally.

- Music Scholarships are awarded on completion of a successful audition and interview.
- The duration of the Music Scholarship is for one academic year only.
- Recipients will receive annual music tuition fees in line with the scholarship policy, for one performing medium, with a College appointed instrument or vocal tutor.
- Upon receipt of a Music Scholarship students will receive a certificate and an information letter outlining procedures and tutor nominations.

On acceptance of a Music Scholarship the student must agree to the following conditions:

- Regular and punctual attendance to instrumental/vocal lessons.
- Choral and Vocal scholarship students are to attend Choir. It is expected that choir students will participate in the Catholic Performing Arts Festival and other College events and performances as required.
- Instrumental scholarship students must actively participate in a Band, Music Ensemble or Orchestra. It is expected that instrumental students will participate in the Catholic Performing Arts Festival and other College events and performances as required.
- All Music Scholarship students are strongly encouraged to enter the Catholic Performing Arts Festival as a soloist.
- Scholarship students are encouraged to choose and participate in Music as a subject from Year 7 to Year 12.
- Once the scholarship has been awarded there is no provision to change to another instrument.

- Students are expected to commit to the College choir/music ensemble program for the duration of the one year scholarship.

At regular lessons and rehearsals, the attitude, commitment and attendance of students will be assessed by the Music Tutors. Failure to meet the above criteria will result in an interview with the Head of The Arts and if there is no significant improvement noted this will lead to the withdrawal of the scholarship.

AUDITIONS

- Auditions require candidates to prepare two contrasting pieces on the instrument/voice of their choice.
- Recommended time limit of two minutes per item.
- Accompanists are available for vocalists' auditions.
- Please provide copies of:
 - a) your audition piece
 - b) relevant music reports
 - c) music exams certificates
 - d) accompaniment music

Audition schedules and details will be emailed to candidates after the closing date of applications.

Emmanuel Catholic College **Music Scholarship Policy**

Scholarship Type:

Individual Music Scholarship \$1120 per annum

(based on 32 half-hour lessons at \$35.00 per lesson)

A Music Scholarship may be awarded per annum at the discretion of the Principal

Conditions of Nominations:

A Student may nominate in Term 3 for a Music Scholarship audition and interview for the following year.

- Nominees must be enrolled at Emmanuel Catholic College.
- Year 8 – Year 12 nominees must have been committed to the music program at the College for one year prior to nomination.
- Nominees must be receiving instrumental, voice or choral lessons with a qualified music tutor.

Music Scholarship Audition and Interview Panel:

Music Scholarship Auditions and interviews are conducted annually by a small panel, consisting of The Head of The Arts, Director of Music and one or two selected Peripatetic Music Staff currently employed at the College.

Acceptance of a Music Scholarship:

A Music Scholarship will only be awarded after a successful audition and interview and only after Parent/s and Student have signed the Music Scholarship Acceptance Form.

Music Scholarship Acceptance Form:

By accepting a Music Scholarship, the student hereby agrees to the conditions of acceptance:

- Regular and punctual attendance to instrumental/vocal lessons at all times.
- Choral and Vocal scholarship students are to attend Choir. It is expected that choir students will participate in the Catholic Performing Arts Festival and other College events and performances as required.

- Instrumental scholarship students must actively participate in a Band, Music Ensemble or Orchestra. It is expected that instrumental students will participate in the Catholic Performing Arts Festival and other College events performances as required.
- All Music Scholarship students are strongly encouraged to enter the Catholic Performing Arts Festival as a soloist.
- Scholarship students are encouraged to choose and participate in Music as a subject from Year 7 to Year 12.
- Once the scholarship has been awarded there is no provision to change to another instrument.
- Students are expected to commit to the College choir/music ensemble program for one year following their scholarship.

Music Scholarship Notification:

All successful recipients will be notified before the conclusion of the Academic Year.

Withdrawal of the Scholarship:

Ongoing assessment throughout the year, of the student's attitude, attendance and effort in lessons and at rehearsals will occur in consultation with Music Tutors. Failure to improve attitude, attendance and effort will lead to the withdrawal of the scholarship.
