Dear Parents and Guardians

Students joining Emmanuel Catholic College are required to bring their own device for use at school. To meet the academic requirements of the College, students are expected to bring a laptop as their main device. iPads will be only supported as a secondary device.

At Emmanuel, the IT device policy runs for approximately three years, so many families will find that by carefully selecting the correct device for their child, their device may be suitable for these years and beyond.

I must highlight that student devices should adhere to the minimum specifications required by the College listed below:
