ABORIGINAL BURSARY

Overview

Emmanuel Catholic College offer Aboriginal Bursaries to Indigenous students upon entry to the College.

Application Process:

1. Students must have received and accepted an Offer of Enrolment from the College, or be a current Emmanuel Catholic College student.
2. Applications are to be made prior to commencement at Emmanuel Catholic College and must be submitted no later than the end of Term 3 preceding the year you are applying.
3. Applications must include an endorsement by an Aboriginal group.
4. Applications are to be made online, directly from the [Emmanuel Catholic College website](#).

Conditions

- Applications must be endorsed by an Aboriginal group.
- The Bursary covers 60% of the tuition fee for the duration of enrolment at the College given the student continues to meet all conditions.
- If eligible for the Health Care Card discount, whichever has the greater value (Health Care Card discount or Bursary) will be applied.
- The Bursary applies to tuition fees only. Parents are responsible for all other fees and charges.
- The student is required to have received and accepted an Offer of Enrolment from the College, or be a current Emmanuel Catholic College student.
- The student must maintain a good academic standing and attendance, uphold the College Values and conduct themselves within the College rules and regulations whilst holding the Bursary.
- The student must actively contribute to College life through Service, Academic and Co-Curricular programs.
- The Bursary is subject to review and monitoring and can be withdrawn if conditions are not met.
- The Bursary Application process is administered by College personnel.
- The Principal is responsible for making the final decision and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The Principal reserves the right to withdraw a Bursary should the recipient seriously breach College rules and regulations.
