

# Emmanuel Catholic College SPECIALIST ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIPS

#### Overview

The Emmanuel Catholic College Specialist Academy Scholarships are awarded to students who are entering the College in Year 7. These scholarships cover the individual's Academy kit and 25% of the tuition fees for Year 7.

Selection is based on evidence of a positive reference along with a trial showcasing necessary skills, attitude, and experience. Applicants who have not received access to prior coaching yet shows potential will still be considered.

The following scholarships are on offer:

- **Emmanuel Football Academy** (1 male and 1 female scholarship awarded)
- **Emmanuel Netball Academy** (1 scholarship awarded)
- **Emmanuel Basketball Academy** (1 male and 1 female scholarship awarded)

# **Application Process:**

- 1. Applications are made online, directly from the <u>Emmanuel Catholic College website</u>. Applications open on Wednesday 26 July 2023.
- 2. Applicants are required to complete and submit the online form and include the following supporting documentation:
  - a. Personal Statement detailing why you should receive this scholarship,
  - b. Club Reference (if applicable).
- 3. Applications close at 4.00pm on Wednesday 23 August 2023. Any applications received after this date will not be accepted.
- 4. Applicants will be required to attend trials at the College during Term 3, Weeks 7/8. (Parents will be notified of the times, dates and places and other relevant information regarding this trial once the application window has closes).
- 5. Monitored ongoing progress throughout the Scholarship tenure.

# Conditions

- Given the student meets the set criteria Parents/Guardians are responsible for any other fees and charges.
- The Scholarship does not include any other specific purpose charges. Parents are also responsible for Resource Fees, books and resources and school uniforms.

- If eligible for the Health Care Card discount, whichever has the greater value (Health Care Card discount or Scholarship) will be applied.
- If not currently enrolled, a student is required to accept an Offer of Enrolment from the College, and pay the Application for Enrolment and Enrolment Fees prior to accepting the Scholarship.
- The student must maintain a good academic standing and attendance, uphold the College Values and conduct themselves within the College rules and regulations whilst holding the Scholarship.
- The student must actively contribute to College life through Service, Academic and Co-Curricular programs.
- The Scholarship is subject to review and monitoring throughout the year and can be withdrawn if conditions are not met.
- The Scholarship Application and Assessment process is administered by College personnel.
- The Principal is responsible for making the final decision and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The Principal reserves the right to withdraw a Scholarship should the recipient underachieve or seriously breach College rules and regulations.
- Students who receive a Specialist Academy Scholarship agree to participate in College promotions of the Specialist Academy program and future Specialist Academy Scholarship advertising.
