



Emmanuel Catholic College ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Overview

The Emmanuel Catholic College Academic Scholarships are awarded to academically able students who are entering the College in Year 7 or Year 10.

Each Scholarship covers up to 50% of the standard annual tuition fee given the student meets the set criteria at the end of each year. Parents/Guardians are responsible for any other fees and charges.

Years 7-9 Academic Scholarship (*apply in Year 6*)

The College offers two (or equivalent) scholarships to students who are entering the College in Year 7. These scholarships cover up to 50% of the tuition fees for Years 7, 8 and 9, given the student meets the set criteria at the end of each year.

Years 10-12 Academic Scholarship (*apply in Year 9*)

The College offers two (or equivalent) scholarships to students who are entering Year 10. These scholarships cover up to 50% of the tuition fees for Years 10, 11 and 12, given the student meets the set criteria at the end of each year.

Application Process:

1. Applications are made online, directly from the [Emmanuel Catholic College website](#). Applications open on Monday 19 August 2024.
2. Applicants are required to complete and submit the online form and include the following supporting documentation:
 - a. Applicant's Year 6/9, Semester One School Report,
 - b. NAPLAN Results from Year 5/9.
3. Applications close at 4.00pm on Monday 9 September 2024. Any applications received after this date will not be accepted.
4. Shortlisted applicants will be required to sit the ACER Scholarship Test (Parents will be notified, if successful, of the time, date and place and other relevant information regarding this examination).
5. Monitored ongoing progress throughout the Scholarship tenure.

Conditions

- If eligible for the Health Care Card discount, whichever has the greater value (Health Care Card discount or Scholarship) will be applied.
- If not currently enrolled, a student is required to accept an Offer of Enrolment from the College, and pay the Application for Enrolment and Enrolment Fees prior to accepting the Scholarship.
- The student must maintain a good academic standing and attendance, uphold the College Values and conduct themselves within the College rules and regulations whilst holding the Scholarship.
- The student must actively contribute to College life through Service, Academic and Co-Curricular programs.
- The Scholarship is subject to an annual review and monitoring throughout the year by the Head of Innovation and Engagement and can be withdrawn if conditions are not met.
- The Scholarship Application process is administered by College personnel.
- Shortlisted students will sit Australian Council for Education Academic Scholarship test, administered by College staff.
- The Principal is responsible for making the final decision and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The Principal reserves the right to withdraw a Scholarship should the recipient underachieve or seriously breach College rules and regulations.
- Students who receive an Academic Scholarship agree to participate in College promotions of the Academic program and future Academic Scholarship advertising.
