Procedures

The following Awards are presented to students:

Principal's Academic Honours

- This is a highly prestigious Award and is presented at a Whole School Assembly to students, in all Year groups, who have achieved an exemplary Semester One or End of Year Reports, thereby reflecting academic excellence in their course of study. The recipients must achieve straight 'A' grades with the allowance of one other grade. This other grade must not be lower than a 'C' grade. The number of 'A' grades varies for Year group to year group as the number of subjects studied varies.
- The HOY is responsible for determining the recipient of the Award.
- Students will be presented with the Principal's Academic Honours certificate at a Whole School Assembly following a reporting period.

Principal's Values Award

- Handed out Whole School Assembly
- Students to have nominations from more than one College value, from Merit Awards.
- Data extracted from College Values Awards spreadsheets by the Head of Innovation and Head of Wellbeing in conjunction with the Deputy of Community.
- Awards given to students to the top students in each year group that go across two or more values.

Merit Awards

- Handed out Year Group Assembly
- Awarded to one student in each class for every subject.
- These awards are awarded according to College values.
