

Emmanuel Catholic College SPECIALIST ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIPS

Overview

The Emmanuel Catholic College Specialist Academy Scholarships are awarded to students who are entering the College in Year 7. These scholarships cover the individual's Academy kit and 25% of the tuition fees for Year 7.

Selection is based on a positive reference along with a trial/audition showcasing necessary skills, attitude, and experience. Applicants who have not received access to prior coaching yet shows potential will still be considered. Please note that all scholarships are subject to a successful application into the College.

The following scholarships are on offer for 2026:

- Emmanuel Football Academy (1 male and 1 female scholarship awarded)
- Emmanuel Netball Academy (1 scholarship awarded)
- Emmanuel Basketball Academy (1 male and 1 female scholarship awarded)

Application Process

- Applications are made online, directly from the <u>Emmanuel Catholic College website</u>. Applications open on Monday 28 April 2025.
- 2. Applicants are required to complete and submit the online form and include the following supporting documentation:
 - a. Personal Statement detailing why you should receive this scholarship,
 - b. Club Reference (if applicable).
- 3. Applications close at 4.00pm on Friday 4 July 2025.

Any applications received after this date will not be accepted.

- 4. Applicants will be required to attend trials at the College during Term 3 (parents will be notified of the times, dates and places and other relevant information regarding this trial once the application window has closes).
- 5. Monitored ongoing progress throughout the Scholarship tenure.

Conditions

- Given the student meets the set criteria Parents/Guardians are responsible for any other fees and charges.
- The Scholarship does not include any other specific purpose charges. Parents are also responsible for Resource Fees, books and resources and school uniforms.
- If eligible for the Health Care Card discount, whichever has the greater value (Health Care Card discount or Scholarship) will be applied.
- If not currently enrolled, you will be required to apply for a position at the College and, should your child be successful in securing a position, you will need to accept an Offer of Enrolment from the College. Applying for, and accepting the position require the payment of the Application for Enrolment and Enrolment Fees prior to accepting the Scholarship.
- The student must maintain a good academic standing and attendance, uphold the College Values and conduct themselves within the College rules and regulations whilst holding the Scholarship.
- The student must actively contribute to College life through Service, Academic and Co-Curricular programs.
- The Scholarship is subject to review and monitoring throughout the year and can be withdrawn if conditions are not met.
- The Scholarship Application and Assessment process is administered by College personnel.
- The Principal is responsible for making the final decision and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The Principal reserves the right to withdraw a Scholarship should the recipient underachieve or seriously breach College rules and regulations.
- Students who receive a Specialist Academy Scholarship agree to participate in College promotions of the Specialist Academy program and future Specialist Academy Scholarship advertising.
